



Family Services of the Piedmont, Inc.

Funds were used to develop the Community Garden Project of the Southside Neighborhood in Highpoint. In collaboration with multiple local organizations they provided educational workshops and workdays for garden visitors, and hosted a National Family Week educational event. A total of 281 adults and 380 children attended these events.

Increasing knowledge of healthy lifestyles and an increase in their vegetable and/or fruit intake were outcomes of this project. A secondary component was the increased social contact with other community gardeners.
