

## AGGIE COMMITMENT

North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University (NC A&T) received a \$1,509,380 traditional grant, (2020-2026) to expand their AggiePlus program with a focused STEM pathway called Aggie Commitment. The Aggie Commitment supports the universities' dual-admission program with eleven NC community colleges. The Aggie Commitment is specifically focused on science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) majors. The program is designed to support 30 students annually, and support 90 STEM students over the life of the grant. Once students transfer to NC A&T they will be given scholarships, aided with work study options, and provided opportunities for research positions at the university.
