

Julius L. Chambers Visiting Scientist

The North Carolina GlaxoSmithKline Board of Directors approved a traditional grant for \$50,000 in 2014 to establish The Julius L. Chambers Visiting Scientist Program. The educational program is designed to expose faculty and students to a distinguished scientist and engage them through short courses, workshops and/or seminars and lectures. The scientist will make two formal presentations to campus-wide audiences focusing on his/her research. The scientist will also review and critique faculty and student research and provide feedback on research and career paths. The program will also include a special lecture for the undergraduate North Carolina GlaxoSmithKline Foundation STEM Scholars. The program will be implemented under the JLC-BBRI, a research center on campus named for Julius L. Chambers.
