



Ruvane Endowed Scholarship

The endowed scholarship for \$50,000 established in 2000 honors the contributions of Joseph J. Ruvane, Jr., to the academic and scientific community of the Research Triangle area. Mr. Ruvane was the President, Chief Executive Officer and Chairman of Glaxo Wellcome Inc from 1981 until 1988 providing an excellent model of leadership and professional excellence. He served on the boards of visitors of Duke University's Fuqua School of Business, the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and Guilford College. In his name, a scholarship to North Carolina Central University will be awarded to an outstanding public high school student with demonstrated leadership skills, documented community service and career aspirations in the natural sciences while meeting class rankings set in the scholarship. The scholarship will be awarded based on need and will be renewable if the recipient maintains at least a 2.6 cumulative GPA.
